I. Administrative Procedures

II. Reports

- A. Usage Report for Saturdays after 6pm (handout)
 - i. When changes to the ARC's hours have occurred, it has been done in the fall.
 - ii. When the ARC opened, the standard closing time for most schools was between 10pm and 11pm – the ARC closed at 12 midnight.
 - iii. Several years later, the other schools were staying open later and the weekday closing time was move to 1am. The later time has been very beneficial for Intramural's.
