Personal recording and/or streaming of any kind is prohibited.
- Violence, bullying, harassment, discrimination, intimidation, and abuse of any type, real or threatened, towards any member of the community will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the program.
- Accessing, posting, or displaying any harmful or inappropriate pictures or materials that may be perceived as threatening, inappropriate, or offensive is strictly prohibited.
- All communications with other participants, instructors, faculty, and staff must be program-related. Sending of unsolicited communication, of any kind, is prohibited.
- Copying the work of others, allowing other to knowingly copy work, and/or misusing content from the internet is prohibited. Sharing the work of others with anyone outside the program is prohibited.
- Participants are encouraged to immediately stop and report any incidents that do not seem right or makes a participant feel uncomfortable by emailing camprec@uci.edu, calling 949.824.5346, and/or [filing an anonymous report online](#).
- Appropriate behavior and dress are expected at all times.
